

Our world is filled with words. And words hold power. Power to build up, and power to break down.

With the flood of language around us, we found ourselves asking, "What words are we feeding our minds?"

Deeply passionate about God's Word, Ornella felt called to initiate in-depth Bible studies tailored to our Belong members in Rwanda. She spends up to three hours preparing for each meeting, diving into Scripture, and considering questions for each member's story. In Bible study time, Belong members have the opportunity to ask questions and grow more in their faith in the freedom to voice any uncertainties they've had.

We love how Ornella leaned into God's prompting to begin these Bible studies, as they have become the standard for how we want Belong together to grow. We can't wait to see what fruit comes from Belong members understanding and growing in God's Word more and more.

"Claude is from the Gihembe refugee camp and a member of our second Belong group, B2. He's currently in his first year of university in Kigali, yet living in the city hasn't been without its challenges. In a recent conversation, Claude told me that in the middle of his struggles, Friday has become his favorite day of the week because it's the day we meet for Bible study. You can imagine how encouraged I was after that! In fact, he has started to share about the way of salvation in his Bible group at school! I'm hoping that through doing more Bible studies, and by God's help, he will be more confident in his beliefs."

A MESSAGE FROM ORNELLA

Ange, a member of our B2 group, grew up in church. She has been in the choir from her childhood, and she does her best to respect the Sabbath day. But something that was missing from her life was reading the Bible. She knew only what they would teach her at church.

When we were in one of our monthly Belong group meetings, the question was raised, "If you were asked why God should let you enter His Kingdom, what would be your answer?"

Almost everyone, Ange included, said they would remind God of their good works.

Then I asked, "If you died right now, would you be accepted? Have you already done enough good works for your acceptance?"

They said they still have a long way to go. Most of them argued that their conscience still has things to accuse them of. Therefore, they said they weren't ready to appear before God.

From this conversation in our group meeting, I knew God was leading us to take a look at what God's Word says about salvation, what grace means, and if we, in our sin, can ever be perfect enough by our own works to enter God's Kingdom.

In a one-on-one time with Ange after talking about these things, she looked thoughtfully at me and said, almost to herself, "What would have happened if I didn't meet you?"

Of course, I got curious. She explained...

"Among all the people around me, absolutely no one had ever told me and explained that we are saved by God's grace through faith. Some people just don't care about God and what He says. Others believe in work-based salvation. If my pastors knew about this, it's strange, because they never told me. Or maybe they said it, but I was too blind to see it as it was. I'm familiar with the verses where Jesus says He's the way, the truth and the life, that no one goes to God the Father except through me (Jesus). But, I never understood what it meant. I had never understood what it means Biblically to believe in Jesus as your only possible Savior. And if it's really that serious and exclusive, it means people who don't believe it believe in the wrong gospel or don't believe at all."

She seemed shocked but also happy to be convicted that she knows the Truth now and she believes it. In the following meeting, we went back to the previous questions a little bit and I was happy and grateful to hear her professing that she's saved, accepted by God through Jesus on the cross!


Right now, you can be a part of what God is doing in Belong Together through...

Kinyarwanda Bibles: The Rwandan Bible Society prints incredible Kinyarwanda study Bibles. These Bibles not only contain the NIV translation in Kinyarwanda, but are also loaded with notes and references that provide so much insight to the text. These Bibles are \$17 each. We would love to get a copy of the Bible in Kinyarwanda to each of our Belong members in Rwanda. With three new groups starting, we want to have 30 copies on hand. (\$17 for one Bible, \$510 for all 30!)

Equip Disciples: One of the ways we share God's love is by equipping our Belong groups with support and provisions to regularly meet. Those things look like snacks, workbooks, supplies, transport and dedicated group leaders.

For each of the three new Belong groups in Rwanda, \$375 will cover the needs for a group of 10 people each month. We would be honored to have you champion one of the new groups as they launch.

Ornella's Pastor Training: Ornella is being further equipped as a ministry leader by being part of pastoral training for the next year in Rwanda. What an opportunity! Each module is \$200, and there are six total. We'd love to have you sponsor one of the modules Ornella will be taking! (\$200 for one module, \$1,200 for all six)
