TAYLOR'S NOTE

They say having a child changes your life. And until you have a child, I don't think you realize how all-encompassing this statement is.

A child does change your life. Nursing. Diapers. Spit up. Those giggles! Did I mention nursing? Changes that drive you into deeper dependence on God, and create in you a capacity to love more than you knew you could.

Though it has only been five months since my son, Jackson Gakundi Jr., "JJ," was born, the Lord has already graciously taught me many lessons. One of those lessons is about priorities.

A day looks different with a little one. The same amount of hours pass on the clock, but not all the things you used to do will get done. That's okay, but it means one must learn their priorities.

Recently, my husband and I talked about and prayed over our family's priorities. Bible study and family worship, keeping the house clean, exercise and wholesome meals, to name a few.

But another priority for us is part of God's great commission: **to share the Gospel**. To, as Jesus said, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you" (Matthew 28:19-20).

As Christians, the first person we are charged to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with is our children (Deuteronomy 6:7). Our mission field is our children. As vital as nourishing our son's physical body is nourishing his spiritual body, for we know he not only possesses a mortal body but an eternal soul. While it is God's will what happens to our son, He has put us in a position of great responsibility to diligently teach His Word, that our son may one day come to faith in Christ (Romans 10:17).

We are not alone in the burden of this priority. The church in Rwanda is filled with parents (and young adults who pray to one day become parents) whose call is to share the Gospel to their children and instruct their sons and daughters in the way of the Lord. One of the avenues they hope to do this is through homeschooling their children with a Biblical curriculum, just as we hope to do for our son when he is old enough.

By God's providence, He has given our family a deep connection with Rwanda. In a time when we are learning the weight and joy of raising our son to know the Lord, we thank God He has put us in a position to shepherd the ministry of Belong Together in Rwanda, to serve His flock, and share the Good News to the lost in that nation. Through the Homeschool Center we hope to begin soon, we pray God supplies resources for the families we serve to be equipped to take responsibility fo their children's education and to grow in their faith in Christ. As we look back to the year God allowed Belong Together to begin in 2018, we are grateful for those He has used in the founding and growth of this ministry. And as a new parent speaking on behalf of young families in Rwanda, we pray His will is to involve you in helping share the Good News of Jesus Christ in this nation, and especially to our children.

Newest Project, our Homeschool Center

The Bible speaks to parents' responsibility to teach their children God's commands (Deuteronomy 6:7) and to train them in the way they should go (Proverbs 22:6). After hearing from young Christian families in Rwanda about their desire to see their children learn all facets of their education from a Biblical lens, we have decided to open a Homeschool Center to help equip parents to educate their children!

We wanted to share with you a little more about BTM's Homeschool Center that we hope to open soon, Lord willing, with your help!

- Our inaugural homeschool group will consist of 10 families, but our capacity with one trainer can reach up to 50. Unlike traditional schools, homeschooling keeps the "teacher -to-student ratio" as low as possible. And who could have more incentive for their child to succeed in their education than their parents?!
- BTM's Homeschool Center will offer Accelerated Christian Education curriculum (A.C.E.) which is used in 145 countries and can begin with children as early as 3, up to Grade 12. Parents can trust they are using a curriculum accredited in Rwanda that is self-paced and incorporates the Bible in every subject.



- Of the parents we've spoken to, the primary reasons they want to homeschool their children are to educate their sons and daughters with a Christian curriculum, to have their children in a safe environment, and to take direct responsibility for their education as the Bible teaches.
- Some of the top concerns parents have about homeschooling are that the concept of homeschooling is new to them, they are unsure what to do if they get stuck on material they don't understand, and their need for a community for support, interaction and prayer.

At BTM's Homeschool Center, parents will receive thorough training before beginning their homeschool venture, as well as support and regular check-ins throughout the year. Additionally, the center will serve as a place where homeschool parents and students can interact, attend special classes and events, and have access to a library of resources. Lord willing, as the center grows and students move on to more advanced subjects, we will have co-op style classes and labs where experts can teach students in areas beyond their parents' skill level – like quantum physics! :)

• Some of the activities we plan to have for homeschool families in our first year are clubs like French, Reading and Sports!
